COMPLAINT TO THE PUBLIC SERVICES OMBUDSMAN FOR WALES

At the beginning of September 2018 the Council was informed that the Ombudsman's office had received a complaint from a Community resident. The complaint was about an individual Councillor and was made under the Code of Conduct for members of local authorities. The complaint was related to a breach of planning conditions and the Councillor's conduct in respect of the way the breach was treated at a Community Council meeting in July 2018.

On 28 September 2018 the Ombudsman issued a further letter, stating that it had been decided not to investigate the complaint as the allegations did not constitute a breach of the Code mentioned above. The Ombudsman has now closed the case.
